**Using Video to Support Vocabulary Development**

**Building Background with Photo Story 3**

August 6, 2009

Combine images, audio, and special effects to create a photo story to build background for a reading selection or to launch a unit or theme in your English Language Arts adoption. Examine the research behind using multimedia to support learning and delve into your ELA curriculum to find where multimedia is an appropriate tool. Learn how to use Photo Story 3, free downloadable Windows software, and create a photo story, complete with narration, motion, and music to support your English Language Arts program.
