Making Inferences

- Instead of just telling you the information directly, authors sometimes put **clues** in the story.
- When you try to figure out the information from the **clues** you are **making inferences**.



Making Inferences

Readers have to use their own knowledge to figure out clues about characters, settings or events of a story.
