Story Structure

The main elements of **story structure** are:

- Characters
 - People or animals in the story
- Plot
 - Series of events in the story
- Setting
 - Time and place in which the story occurs

- How can you tell?

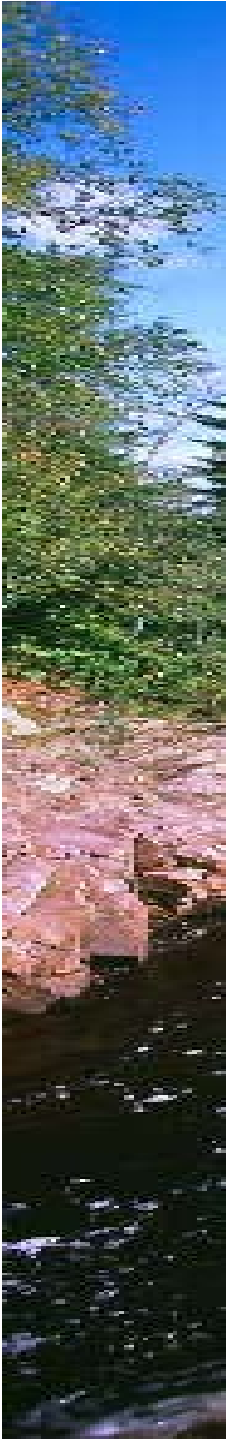




While You Read
