- Do you know of any shipwrecks?



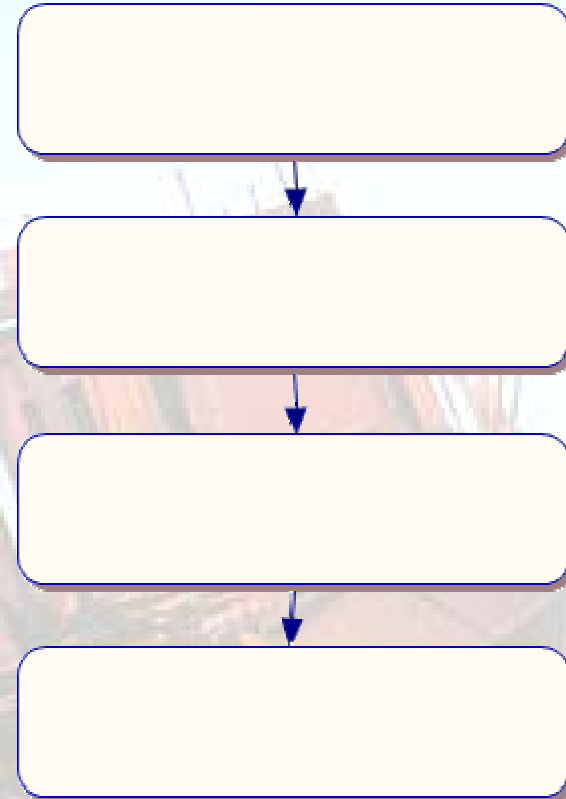
Activate Prior Knowledge
