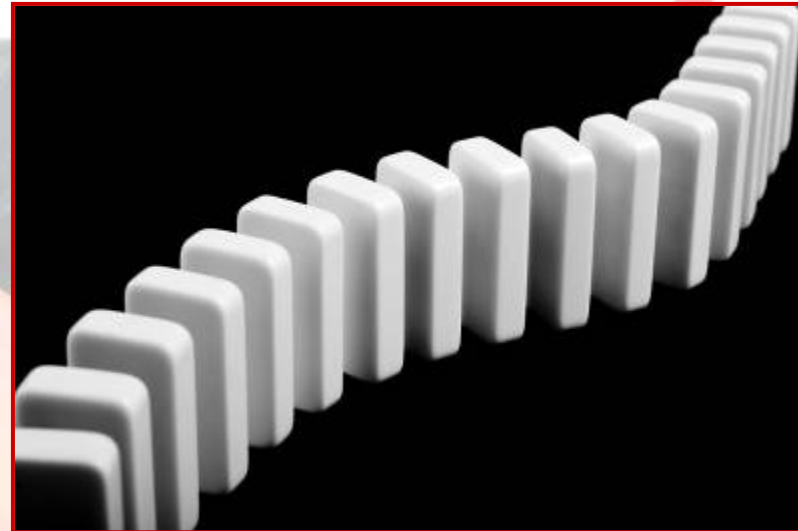
- Can you recall any courageous rescues you've seen or heard about?

- How is it helpful to know this?

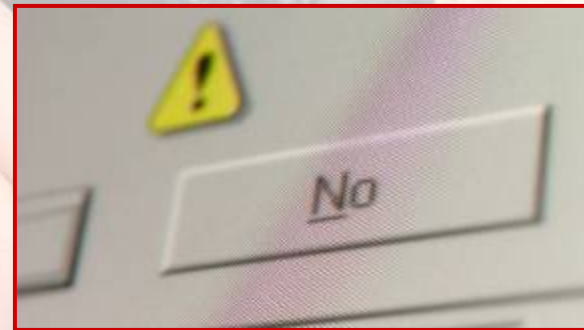
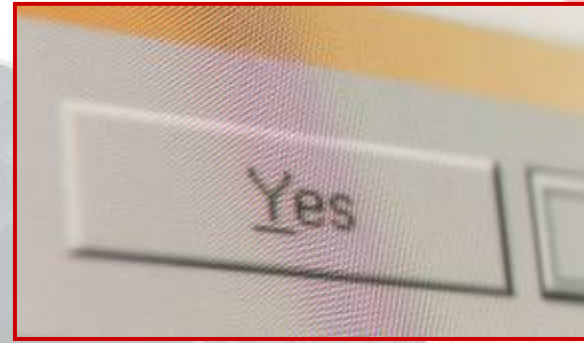
