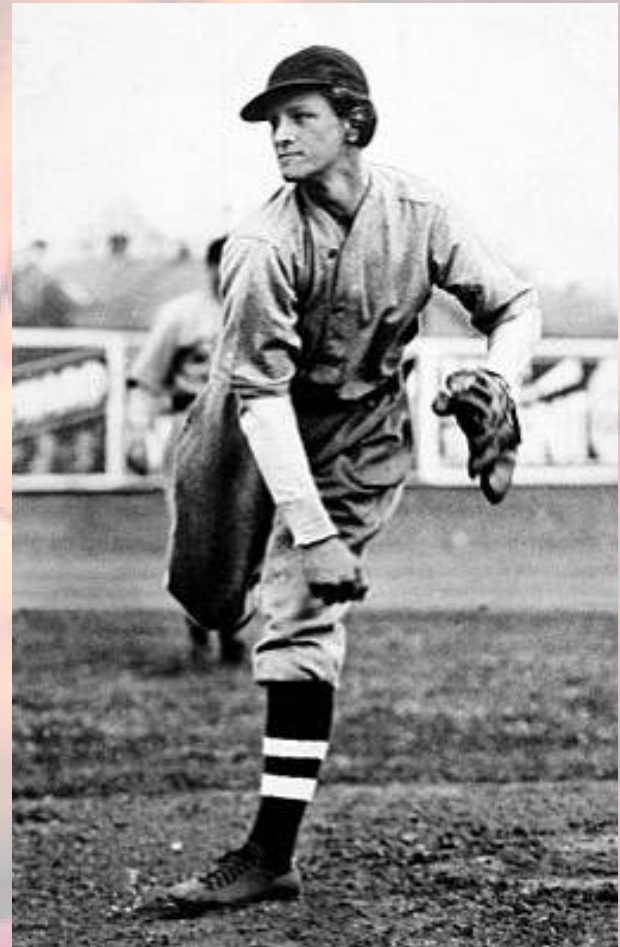
“Babe Didrikson”

- A **biography** is a factual account of an actual person’s life, written by someone else.

Babe excelled at sports during a time when very few women could make careers as professional athletes.



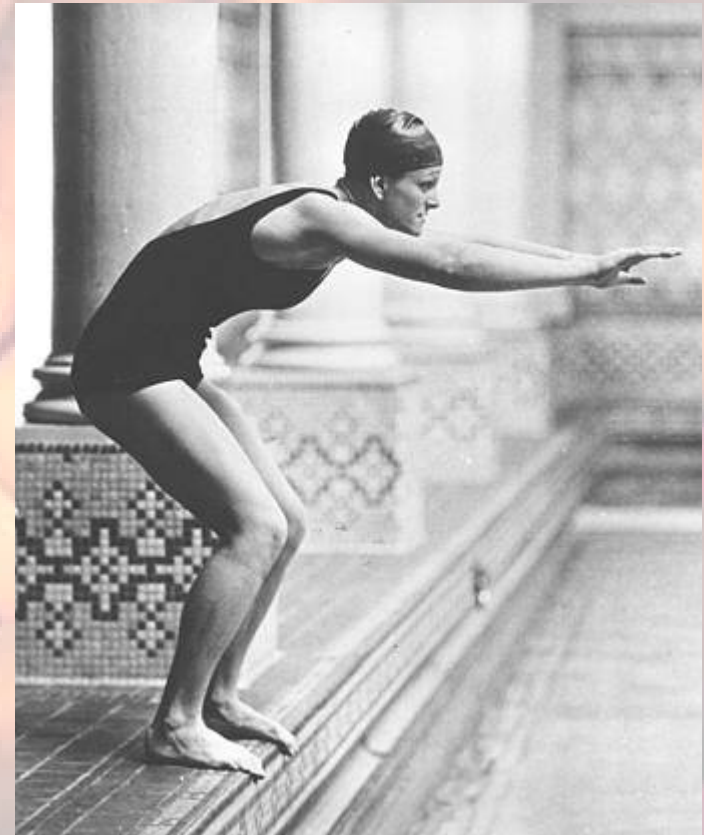
“Babe Didrikson”

- Amelie wrote projects designed to empower girl readers.
- She tells aspiring writers, “...Everyday practice improves writing skills and generates ideas. Also, reading is a great way to get inspiration and to learn about different forms & styles of writing.”

How did Babe’s strong **competitive** streak help her later in life?



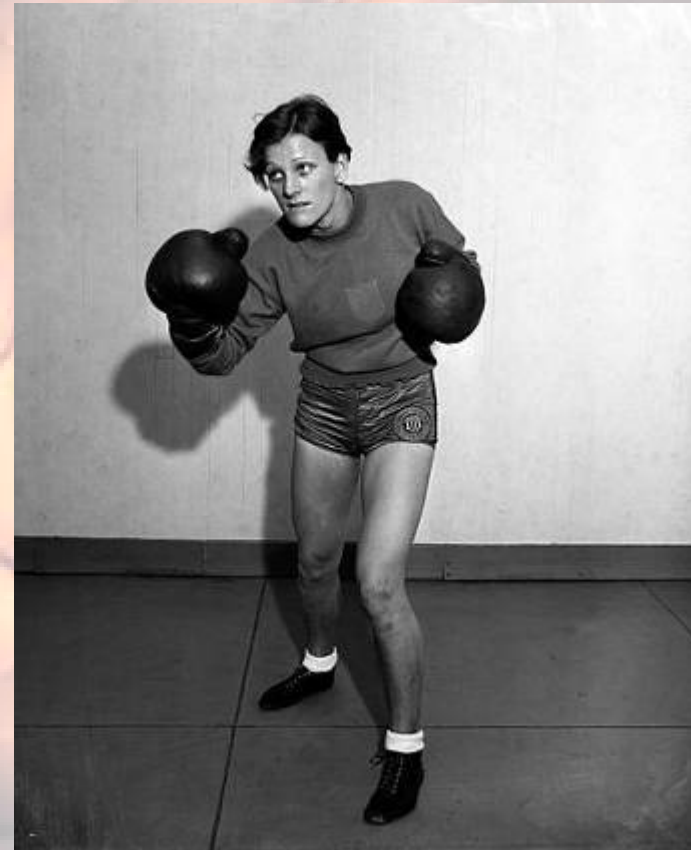
Discussing “Babe Didrikson”
